PALM TERRACE

Grantley Adams International Airport (BGI) is located 12 miles (19 km) east of town, near Christ Church.

Barbados is serviced by: Air Canada, Air Jamaica, American Airlines, British Airways, Virgin Atlantic, BWIA, US Airways, Continental and Delta.

Departure tax: \$13.00 USD for all departures. Passengers in transit who will be remaining in Barbados for less than 24 hours and children (under 12) are exempt.

Traveling from the Airport to the Resort

The Fairmont Royal Pavilion is pleased to assist with travel arrangements.

Guests may choose from the following transportation options to travel from the airport to the resort:

- **Taxi:** There is 24-hour taxi service readily available at the airport. Travel time via taxi is approximately 40 minutes. Rates range from \$25.00 USD to \$30.00 USD.

- **Taxi:** Taxis do not have meters, but the government regulates fares. Listings are available in the hotel lobby. Please ask the driver the price before traveling.
- **Rental Cars:** Our Concierge desk will be more than happy to make your rental arrangements. Remember, Barbados drives on the left side of the road.
- **Parking:** Self-parking is available, free of charge. Bell staff are available for assistance, if needed.
